Purpose: The SR-7A Lodge of the Year Award recognizes the most exceptional all-around lodge in SR-7A. The evaluation is based on the lodge's ability to fulfill the basic purposes of the Order of the Arrow and to participate in section events. Lodges score themselves on objective criteria. The lodge which scores the most points will receive the "Lodge of the Year Award" that year, have its name placed on a circulating award, and receive bragging rights for the year.

Directions: Lodges accrue points between and during Conclaves. Part I of the Lodge of the Year Award measures the strength of the lodge between Conclaves. Part II measures the strength of the lodge at Conclave.

Part I. To compete in Part I, lodges must turn in Part I to the Section Vice Chief no later than the beginning of the Council of Chiefs meeting on Friday night of Conclave. This duty falls to the lodge chief or his designee. Late submissions may result in a lodge receiving zero points.

Part II. Part II, which measures a lodge's success at Conclave, is completed by various Conclave Vice Chiefs, who report on lodges' participation and success in various activities.

- D) Lodge had a time for fellowship with new Ordeal members at night after the Ordeal ceremony. 25 Points _____
- E) Lodge chief spoke directly to new Ordeal members following the night of the taking of their Ordeal, every Ordeal. 25 Points _____
- F) Lodge used the “Nimat Program” for every lodge function at which members had an opportunity to participate in the Brotherhood ceremony; all Nimats were trained prior to each event. 25 Points _____

III. Membership and Unit Support

- A) Lodge had an active dance team that performed regularly at council, district, and public events. 25 Points _____
- B) Lodge offered Arrow of Light ceremonies to each pack in the council and provided a ceremony to each pack requesting one. 25 Points _____

IV. Camp Promotions

- A) Lodge held an Order of the Arrow specific event during each Boy Scout camping week at the council's primary summer camp. 50 Points _____

V. Section and National Participation

- A) Lodge sent at least one representative to each CoC event between Conclaves 50 Points _____

- B) Lodge sent at least two members to a national OA summer program of emphasis. This includes NOAC, an OA high adventure program, staff of national jamboree with an OA committee, or other national OA summer program of emphasis. 50 Points _____

- C) Lodge increased its Early Conclave Registration number by one from the previous year.

Early Conclave Registration means those who registered and paid, by the earliest deadline to do so, using the online registration system

The previous year's Conclave host automatically earns full points. 75 Points _____

- D) Choose only one:

25 points if lodge obtains 85% of attendance goal set by the Section before the late registration deadline.

50 points if lodge meets attendance goal set by the Section before the late registration deadline.

100 points if lodge exceeds attendance goal set by the Section by 15% or more by the late registration deadline.
